



# CHSU Student Scholarships

## Up to \$20,000 in CHSU Scholarships Available for Incoming Class of 2029 Students!

Students enrolled in the incoming class of 2029 CHSU Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine program may be eligible for a \$20,000 CHSU Scholarship to help reduce their educational expenses.

- Up to five (5) \$20,000 scholarships will be awarded
- Up to fifteen (15) \$10,000 scholarships will be awarded

### Eligibility Requirements

- Have been offered and accepted admission for the 2025-2026 academic year at the CHSU College of Osteopathic Medicine (CHSU-COM).
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Meet eligibility for merit and/or financial need.

*Scholarship awards are dispensed at 25% of the maximum amount per semester if the student maintains a 3.0 cumulative GPA and remains in good academic and professional standing each semester at CHSU-COM.*

*For example, a student awarded a \$20,000 CHSU Scholarship and maintained eligibility each semester, would receive four, \$5,000 scholarship awards, one for each of the Fall 2025, Spring 2026, Fall 2026, and Spring 2027 semesters.*
